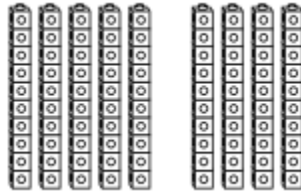


Sums of 90

Materials: snap cubes

1. Work with a partner. Make nine sticks of 10 snap cubes.
2. How many different ways can you put your sticks of 10 into two groups?
3. Show your work using pictures, numbers or words.



$$\begin{aligned} 5 \text{ tens} + 4 \text{ tens} &= 9 \text{ tens} \\ 50 + 40 &= 90 \end{aligned}$$
