# 3.OA The Stamp Collection 

Alignments to Content Standards: 3.OA.D. 8

## Task

Masha had 120 stamps. First, she gave her sister half of the stamps and then she used three to mail letters. How many stamps does Masha have left?

## IM Commentary

This task uses language, "half of the stamps," that students in Grade 5 will come to associate with multiplication by the fraction $\frac{1}{2}$. In Grade 3 , many students will understand half of 120 to mean the number obtained by dividing 120 by 2 . For students who are unfamiliar with this language the task provides a preparation for the later understanding that a fraction of a quantity is that fraction times the quantity.

## Solution

We can visualize the problem with a bar diagram:
in Mathematics


2 units $=120$

1 unit $=60$
$60-3=57$

Masha had 57 stamps left.
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
