

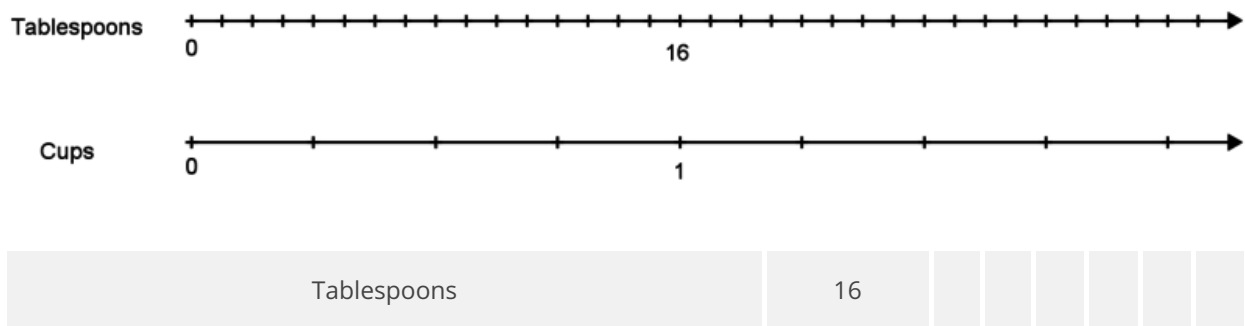
6.RP Simple Unit Conversion Using Ratio Reasoning

Task

Malik is using a cookbook to make a recipe, but he can not find his measuring cups! He has, however, found a tablespoon. Inside the back cover of the cookbook, it says that 1 cup = 16 tablespoons.

- a. Explain how he could use the tablespoon to measure out the following ingredients:
- i. 2 cups of flour
 - ii. $\frac{1}{2}$ cup sunflower seeds
 - iii. $1\frac{1}{4}$ cup of oatmeal
- b. Malik also adds the following ingredients. How many cups of each did he add?
- i. 28 tablespoons of sugar
 - ii. 6 tablespoons of cocoa powder
